

CLASS OF 2016 STUDENTS & PARENTS

As we approach the graduation date for the Class of 2016, we encourage you to review your eligibility to earn a high school diploma and participate in the graduation ceremony. Below you will find a list of requirements and where to go to verify completion.

Graduation Requirements: (See your child’s counselor if you have any questions.)

- Are on track to meet the minimum of 210 credits (you should have received a “senior check”)
- Are on track to pass all required classes (A-G, LAUSD & state requirements)
- Identify a Career Pathway
- Are in the process of completing or have already completed a Service Learning Project

Attendance: (You may check your child’s absences at the Attendance Office.)

- Met the senior attendance requirement (less than 16 full days and less than 16 absences in any one period)

Senior Clearance: (You may check with the SLC Center.)

- Submitted the Class of 2015 Senior Contract
- Cleared all debts (including library, textbooks, uniforms, band equipment, etc.)
- Maintained good behavior per Poly’s Student Standards, including carrying your Poly ID

Graduation Participation: (You may check with the Student Store.)

- Purchase senior package or request cap, gown, and tassel loaner. Requests for loaner must be made by February 11, 2016.

Disregarding these matters may cause the delay or non-issuance of your diploma. Be responsible and ensure all the requirements are met.
