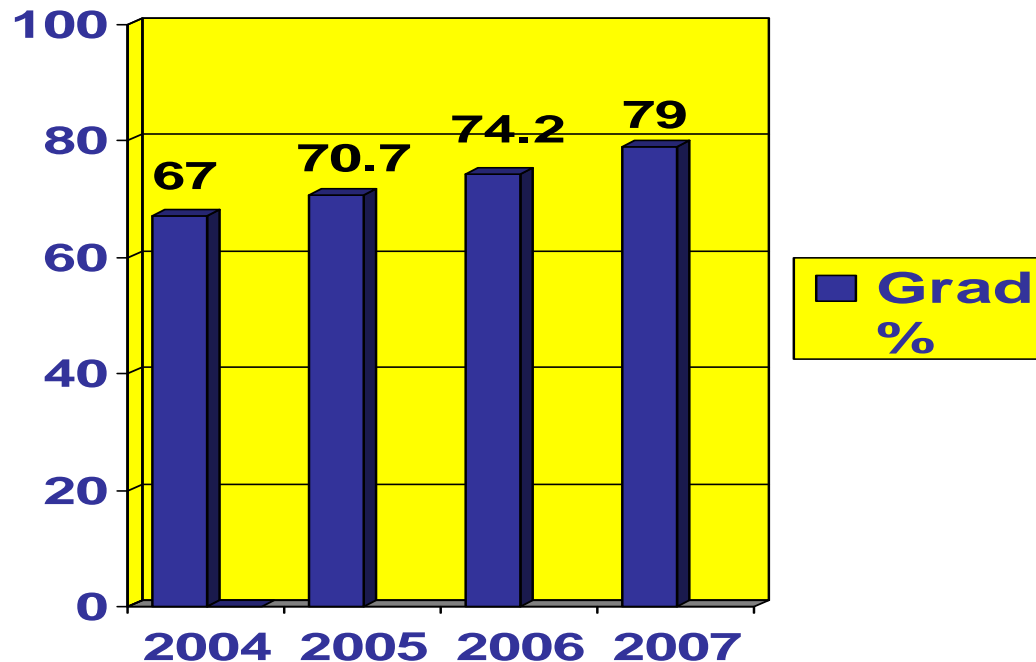

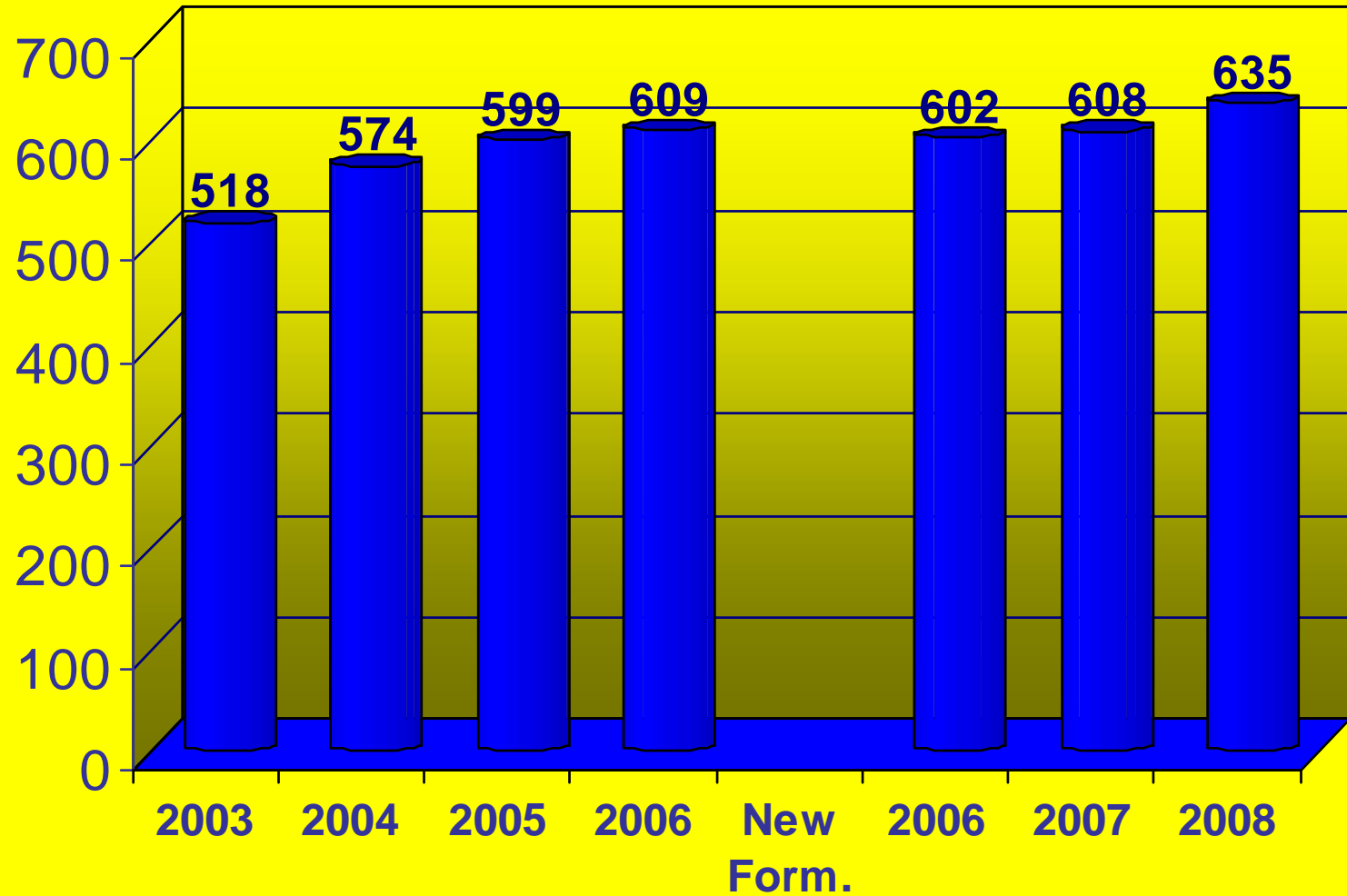


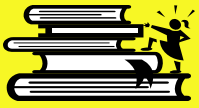
## Critical Findings:

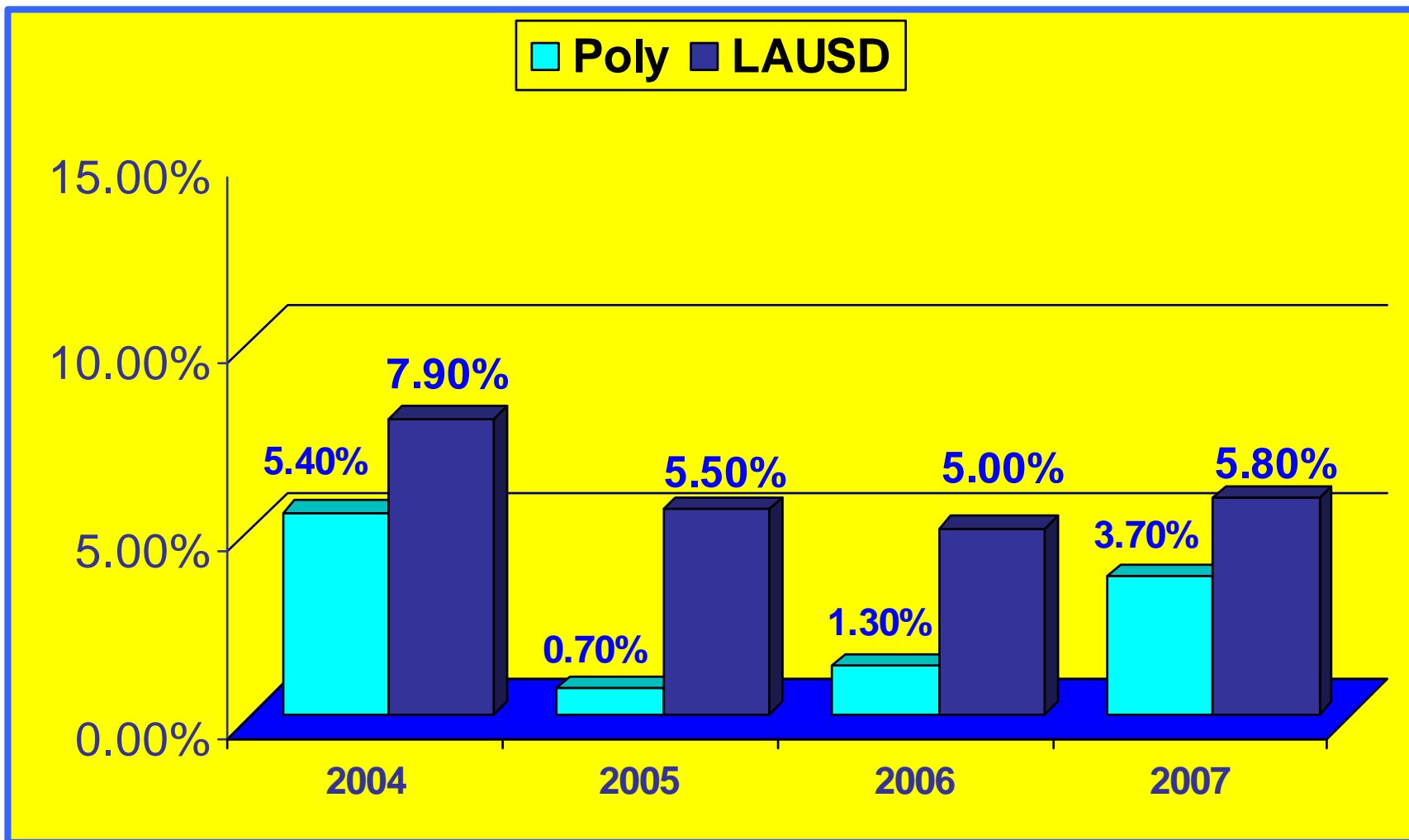
